This year will be bigger and better then ever because we are bringing NOT one but two National Recording Country Music Artists to perform on the K-Country Sound Stage. In addition, the event will be filled with excitement for all ages. From the exciting, high flying Disc -Connected k-9's to a local, BBQ Cook-Off competition. This event will have full support from radio (93.7 K-Country), television, and print media.

SPACE WILL BE LIMITED AN EARLY RESPONSE IS ADVISED.

APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- * Complete application form. *Incomplete applications will be rejected.*
- * Check or Money Order for the **TOTAL** amount for the display space requested including electric & water.
- * Current Certificate of Insurance. (A valid current certificate of insurance is required for any vendor who *sells food items.*)

General "Bark-N-Purr" Rules:

- Registration deadline is **January 15th 2010.**
- Exhibitors are responsible for:
 - Care and protection of the booth areas.
 - General cleanliness during and after event of booth areas.
 - Must provide own display items such as tents, tables, etc.
 - **Exhibits must be contained entirely within designated display area. 20X20**
- Registration is a commitment to exhibit at the Festival. Once an application has been accepted *refunds are not issued for any reason.*
- **Applicant will receive VENDOR PACKET NO LATER THAN JANUARY 30, 2009.**
- **VENDOR WILL ONLY RECEIVE TWO (2) WRISTBANDS PER BOOTH. Additional wristbands can be purchased for \$5.00**
- The Festival is a family-oriented event. No items shall be displayed, offered for sale, distributed or given away which the Festival Committee may deem inappropriate for children. *Any item(s) determined as such will be subject to confiscation by the Humane Society.*
- Vendors do not have exclusive rights to any particular type of craft or item offered to the public. In order to avoid any confusion for the general public, all sales of raffle tickets must be made from vendor's booth. *(no outside sale of tickets permitted)*
- **NO BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND TO BE SOLD.** The Humane Society reserves the right to sell ALL beverages during the two day event.
- **FOOD Vendors will not exchange cash.** The HSLC will utilize "Bark-N-Purr" Bucks. This is the same as cash. Vendors will receive 70% cash payout and HSLC will receive 30%.
- **SET UP**
 - * Exhibitor's Liability on Friday, February 26th 2010, 9:00AM- 4:00pm.
 - * Exhibitor's Liability on Saturday, February 27th 2010, 8:00AM- 12:30pm.
- **SALE OF ANY ITEM BY AN EXHIBITOR PRIOR TO THE OFFICIAL OPENING OF THE FESTIVAL IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- **PARKING**
 - * Designated vendor parking areas prior to 4:15pm, Friday, February 26, 2010 or 1:15pm, Saturday, February 27, 2010.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY THE ENTIRETY OF THE FESTIVAL.**
- **BREAKDOWN** of booths *may not begin prior to 8:00 pm* Saturday, February 27th 2010.
